To Whom It May Concern:

Hamilton Memorial Hospital District in McLeansboro, IL is currently in the process of undertaking an \$18.5 million expansion and renovation project at our hospital that will add approximately 26,000 square feet to our facility. The hospital was opened in 1960 and other than cosmetic and maintenance upgrades, there have not been any major facility upgrades in over 25 years. Our current facility is faced with space constraints, fragmented departments spread throughout the hospital, and mechanical, electrical and utilities systems that have exceeded their life expectancy. With these challenges in mind, our Board of Directors and Administration began to examine where we wanted the hospital to be in the future and how we could achieve these goals. Approximately one year ago, after thorough review, we chose the Murray Company to help us with our project.

I am pleased to recommend the Murray Company to assist in this type of construction project. The team from Murray has taken a very strategic approach to identifying the needs of our organization and has worked with other key professionals to assure that our needs are met.
